Dear Candidate Fiore:

On or about April 30, 2016, when asked by KLAS Channel 8 reporter Steve Sebelius whether you believe citizens have the right to point a gun at a duly authorized law enforcement officer who is lawfully performing their duties, you made the following public comments:

"I would never ever point my firearm at anyone, including an officer of the law, unless they pointed their firearm at me." . . . "Once you point your firearm at me, I'm sorry, then it becomes self-defense. Whether you're a stranger, a bad guy, or an officer, and you point your gun at me and you're gonna' shoot me and I have to decide whether it's my life or your life, I choose my life." (Emphasis added).

On behalf of the hard working men and women who put their lives on the line every day to protect people like you, me, our families and our friends, and who know too well the risks inherent in any confrontation that involves the brandishing and use of deadly weapons, we denounce your recent position that it is acceptable to point a firearm at a duly authorized law enforcement officer if that officer finds the compelling need to point a gun at you.

Your comments underscore your distortion of the Second Amendment and essentially advise your followers that they may point a firearm at a law enforcement officer with impunity and without life and death consequences. You know full well that any citizen who points a firearm at a law enforcement officer will be met with equal deadly force, thus escalating what could have been a peaceful encounter to a deadly encounter in which citizens and law enforcement officers may be injured or killed.

Ms. Fiore, we no longer see you as a passionate advocate for your Second Amendment rights, which we support. Rather, these comments were utterly irresponsible, an embarrassment to your District and our State, and they continue to demonstrate why you are unqualified to hold the position of United States Congresswoman.
