SUMMARY

From May 26th, 2016 to present, the City of Las Vegas, North Las Vegas, and County of Clark had experienced a series of business robberies that have been coined the, "Hog-Leg Series." These robberies all have a similar Modus Operandi.

During these robberies, five Hispanic males described between the ages of 14 to 20 years old entered businesses covering their faces wearing various clothing, armed with knives, machetes, and a black long barrel revolver . The suspects enter in groups of two or three in each robbery. They robbed the clerks of the money in the registers and then fled the businesses in a gold, four door, Dodge sedan. During several of these robberies, the suspects were wearing the same red/black/blue bandanas, pants, shirts, and shoes. It appears the same black revolver handgun is used in all of the robberies. Under LVMPD event #160605-0520, suspects #1 shot the victim in the head. Under LVMPD event #160606-0201, the same suspect shoots one round from the revolver into the ceiling of the business as they entered.

The event number used to connect follow up investigation to this series is LVMPD event # 160605-0520.

The following is a summary of each robbery, where it occurred, what the suspect was described as and what clothing he was wearing. The clothing descriptions that are in **Bold** and *Italics* appear in multiple robberies. Video surveillance and/or stills were obtained from each business robbery.

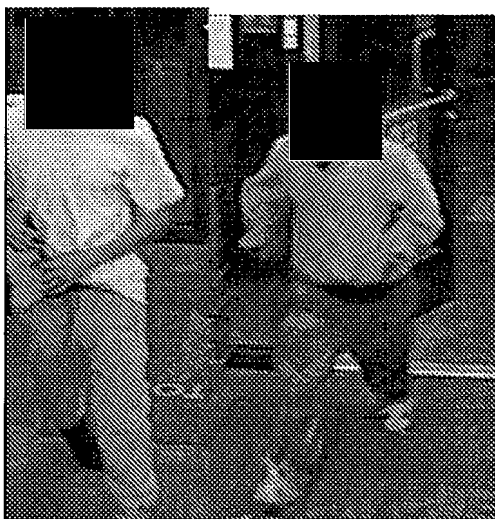

On May 26th, 2016, at approximately 0108 hours, three suspects entered the Maverick gas station at 10490 Bermuda, Las Vegas NV 89183. Video surveillance showed the following descriptions:

Details stated that white and blue 90's model SUV entered the parking lot to the Maverick at 10490 Bermuda Las Vegas, NV 89183. The vehicle drives around the parking lot before parking in a spot close to the doors. One subject exits the SUV and waits outside the SUV until the only customer inside leaves.

Once that customer leaves Perez shoes enters the store. He finds the clerk, Arthur DeLatorre, cleaning. Perez approaches DeLatorre and forces him behind the counter. Perez holds a knife in his right hand while he is guiding DeLatorre to his register. While DeLatorre is opening the register [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] go behind the counter and begin taking cigarettes from the cabinets.

All three suspects ran out the doors and got into the SUV. They then drove northbound on Bermuda.

The total amount of money taken from the register was \$183.00.

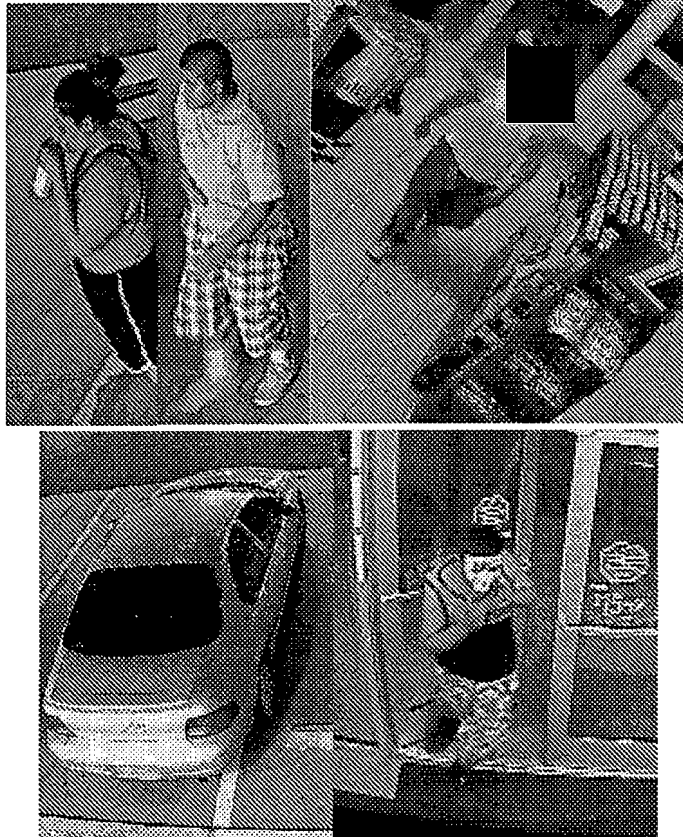

Details stated the suspects entered the AM/PM at approximately 2100 hours wearing masks. Both suspects walked around the counter, one subject produced a knife, and demanded Reyes to open the cash register. The victim Benita Reyes unlocked the cash register. The suspects began taking money from the register and selecting packs of cigars. The two suspects then exited the store. Daniel Velasquez-Wilson was closing Port of Subs inside 330 W. Centennial when he seen a gold, dodge vehicle back in reverse in front of the AM/PM and take off at a high rate of speed.

On June 4th, 2016, at approximately 0200 hours, three suspects entered the Speedie Mart at 2980 E. Tropicana, Las Vegas NV 89121. Video surveillance showed the following descriptions:

Details stated that Perez pulled out a long barrel black revolver from his waistband and pointed it at the victim Carrie Hert. Perez demanded money. Hert filled a brown paper bag with money from the register. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] proceed toward the cigarettes section and remove cigarette packs from the shelf. [REDACTED] demands the victim to open the safe. Hert typed in the code resulting in 1 tube of 20 dollar bills being dispensed. The tube had a total of 100 dollars inside. Perez grabbed the tube and fled the business westbound toward Tropicana Ave. The incident was witnessed by Ruby Espinoza who was sitting at the slot machines during the incident. A pack of Newport cigarettes was found by patrol officers in the parking lot, possibly dropped by one of the suspects.

Both subjects yelled at Tate to give up the money. The suspects stole approximately \$20.00t, store keys, and store phone. They then fled the area in an unknown direction. The Store phone was located just outside the doorway of the business.

Details stated that an unknown trouble call was called into LVMPD dispatch regarding the victim Gene McMillian lying on the ground of the business in a pool of blood. Officers responded and found that the McMillian was suffering from a gunshot wound to the front of the head. Officers found that the register was open and money was missing. Officers found that two customers who entered the building after the robbery and shooting occurred were the callers of the unknown trouble call.

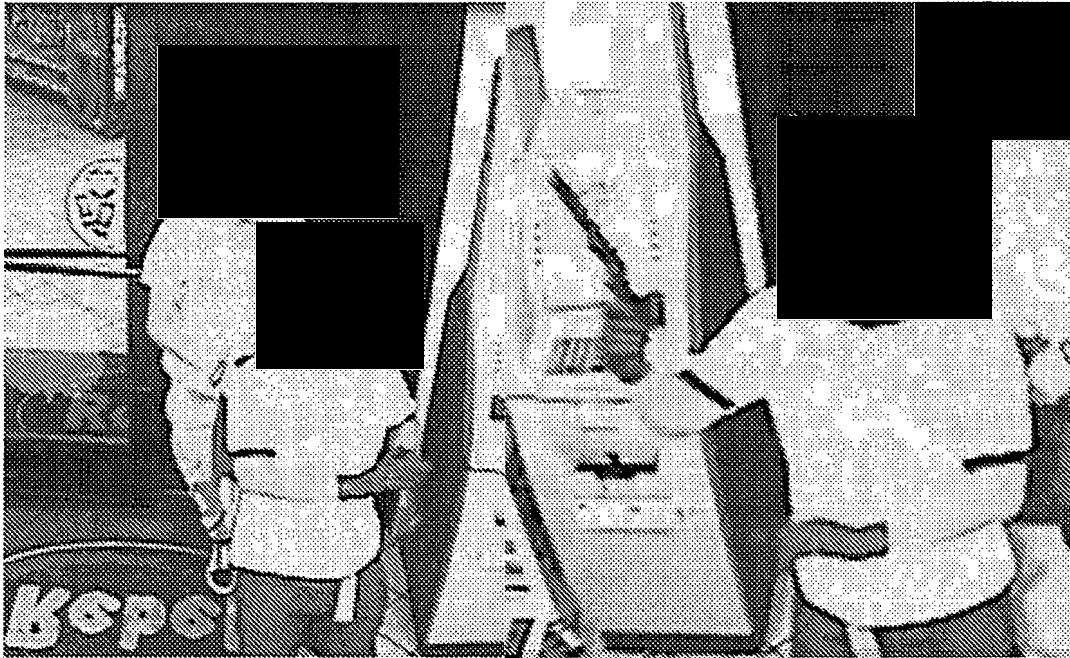

Details stated that upon entering the business, [REDACTED] removes a long barreled revolver from his front waistband and fires one shot into the ceiling. The suspects shout "get on the ground" to four customers that were in the business at the time of the robbery. The suspects then walk around the counter where the victim Dustin Otis was standing and ordered him to open the register. [REDACTED] removes two knives Otis had on his belt. Otis removed all the money from the register and placed it into a backpack [REDACTED] was carrying. [REDACTED] takes a box of Black and Mild cigars and a tray of lighters off the counter. Hernandez picks up a cup from under the counter and dumps the change into the back pack. The suspects exit out the front door. The suspects enter a tan four door sedan with tinted windows. The vehicle was backed in, in a parking spot located on the west side of the building. The vehicle drove off northbound on Rainbow. The suspects took \$325.70.

Details stated that three suspects entered the business wearing masks. Two suspects jumped the counter with guns. [REDACTED] armed with a machete stayed on the outside of the counter. While the two suspects were behind the counter. The victim James Damm was told to give them the money from the drawers. Damm opened both registers for the suspects [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] grabbed all the money from the registers and tobacco products.

[REDACTED] is described as a **Hispanic male, 5'2" to 5'3". 140 lbs, with a black/white bandana covering his hair, with a red mask over his face, tattoo on the left side of his neck, wearing a white shirt with black trim, dark pants, white adidas shoes, and armed with a black long barrel revolver.** [REDACTED]

Details stated that the victim Christopher Soult noticed a vehicle backing into a parking stall just outside of the front door and he went out front to check on the vehicle. Soult stated that the vehicle was gold in color Dodge neon or stratus. The vehicle had no license plate on the rear of the bumper. Soult saw an occupant of the vehicle with a mask over his face. The suspects entered the 7-11 through the front doors wearing masks and head coverings. [REDACTED] had a long barrel revolver. [REDACTED] had a large machete. [REDACTED] Marroquin had a smaller weapon. The suspects ordered him to give them the cash. The suspects directed Soult to the registers. The suspects told Soult to get on the ground after stealing money from registers and merchandise.

INVESTIGATION

Under event 160605-0520 Robbery Detectives responded to 4160 E. Sahara Ave, Las Vegas NV 89121. I began my investigation and reviewed the video surveillance from the 7-11. The surveillance showed two suspects entered the 7-11. [REDACTED] was wearing a red shirt, dark pants, and black bandana over the face, and carrying a long barreled revolver. [REDACTED] points that firearm at the victim McMillian and follows him to the cash register. After McMillian opens the register he walks away looking at [REDACTED] who is at the register. [REDACTED] raised the black long barrel revolver as McMillian looked at him and shot McMillian in the head.

McMillan was transported to Sunrise Medical Center in critical condition. McMillan suffered a bullet wound that has traveled through his brain. The injury has caused severe bleeding and swelling in the brain.

During the investigation, I learned that seven more robberies matched the descriptions of the suspects from May 26th, 2016 to June 6th, 2016.

Follow-up investigation:

Information was provided which identified [REDACTED] DOB [REDACTED] with the long pony tail. A search warrant was obtained for [REDACTED] where [REDACTED] resides. Evidence was recovered at the residence which was directly related to the robberies.

On June 8th, 2016 I was contacted by Cristen Carnell Probation Officer II of the Clark County Juvenile Detention Center. Carnell provided a picture of [REDACTED] DOB [REDACTED] which identified him as suspect #1. Detective E. Cardenas contacted [REDACTED] probation officer A. Ruiz P#1362 of the Clark County Detention Center. Ruiz stated that she had seen the Media releases of the robberies that have occurred in the Las Vegas Valley. Ruiz identified [REDACTED] as the suspect wearing the red shirt in LVMPD event 160605-0520. Ruiz stated that she also identified [REDACTED] as the suspect in LVMPD event 160606-0201 by the tattoo on Gutierrez's left side of the neck. Ruiz stated that on May 24th, 2016, Gutierrez's father [REDACTED] Sr called her and updated his son's address as [REDACTED]

On June 9th, 2016, information was provided that led Detectives to believe [REDACTED] was at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was seen by Detectives exiting the apartment. A search warrant was obtained for apt [REDACTED] Evidence was recovered from the apartment directly related to the robberies and attempt murder.

On June 9th, 2016, [REDACTED] was taken into custody and arrested at [REDACTED] Las Vegas NV 89115. *See suspect statements.*

Video Examination:

On June 9th, 2016, I received the video surveillance of the robbery that occurred at 330 W. Centennial Pkwy, N. Las Vegas NV 89031 under NLVPD event 160602-9496. The video showed a 4 door, gold, Dodge Stratus with damage on the front of the vehicle, no license plate, and a white 97.5 sticker on the rear of the vehicle. Suspect #4 who was later identified as Kimberly Zenteno DOB [REDACTED] was seen exiting the front passenger seat several times in the video as a look out for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as they commit the Robbery. Suspect #6 later identified as Jacqueline Zambrano DOB [REDACTED] exits the driver seat and walks into the AM/PM.

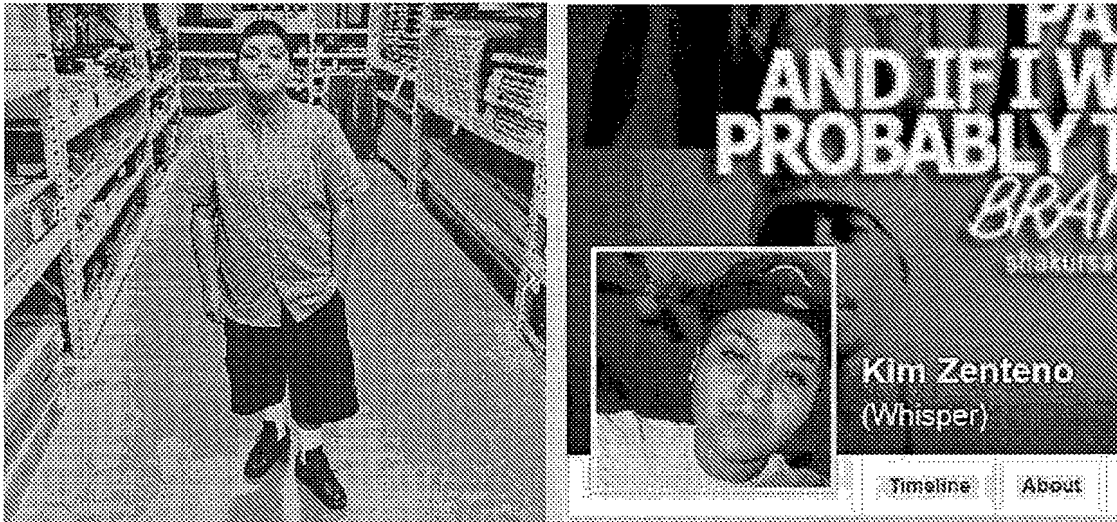
Follow-up Investigation:

Numerous citizen sources provided name of Kimberly Zenteno as the suspect who committed the robbery and attempted murder under event, 160605-0520. The information received from these sources corroborated information provided co-defendants.

Research was conducted on Facebook.com for Kim Zenteno. A profile for Kim Zenteno was found under the same name. Pictures on her profile showed she dressed like a male and matched the surveillance videos in the robberies. It was learned through the Clark County School District that a Trinidad Zenteno resides at [REDACTED]

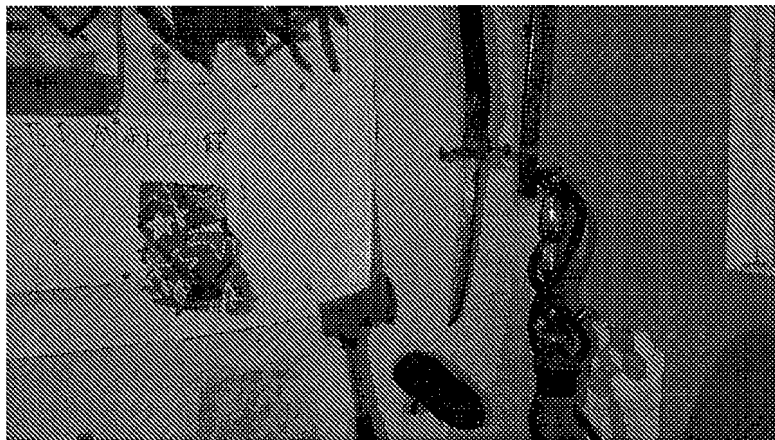


On June 13, 2016, [REDACTED] was taken into custody and arrested at [REDACTED] NV 89081. See suspect statements.

On June 13, 2016, at approximately 2200 hours, Detective Weirauch and Detective Hanshew located the suspect vehicle at [REDACTED]. Detective Weirauch obtained the Vehicle Identification Number from the window that had a 30 day DMV temporary tag. The VIN read 1B3EJ46X1YN107878. A records check of the VIN returned unregistered. Jacqueline Zambrano who was visiting friends at [REDACTED], returned to the vehicle and was arrested. See suspect statement.

On June 15th, 2016, Detectives conducted surveillance at [REDACTED] Las Vegas Blvd 89101. Detectives located Zenteno walking out of the apartment and took her into custody.

A search was obtained for [REDACTED]. The knife/sword seen on video under LVMPD 160605-0430 used by [REDACTED] was located inside [REDACTED] room. Additionally, items directly related to the robberies Zenteno was involved in were recovered from the residence.

INTERVIEWS

SUSPECT STATEMENTS:

██████████ On June 9th, 2016, Detective L. Spiotto and I conducted a recorded interview at 400 S. Martin Luther King Blvd, Metro HQ, with ██████████. Detective Spiotto read ██████████ his Miranda rights which ██████████ stated he understood. During the interview ██████████ stated the following: he committed 6 robberies in the Las Vegas Valley. I showed surveillance videos of the aforementioned events in which he committed. ██████████ identified himself as suspect #2 with the long ponytail. ██████████ was also shown photographs of all eight robberies in which he identified suspect #1 as ██████████. ██████████ identified ██████████ in LVMPD event 16526-0182, 160604-0430, 160605-0430, 160605-0520, 160606-0201, 160606-0426, 160606-0532 and NLVPD event 160602-9496. He also identified Andrew Perez as suspect #3 who committed the robberies under LVMPD event 160526-0182, North Las Vegas event 160602-9496, and LVMPD event 160604-0430. ██████████ identified ██████████ as suspect #5 from LVMPD events 160606-0201, 160606-0426, and 160606-0532 who carried the machete.

██████████ stated the long barrel revolver found at ██████████ Las Vegas NV 89115, is his. ██████████ stated we would find a backpack with tobacco products taken in the robberies. ██████████ stated the driver of the gold/tan dodge 4 door vehicle is called "Fat Bitch". ██████████ stated she drove the suspects to each robbery. ██████████ was shown pictures of Zenteno involved in robberies at the AMPM and 7-11 shooting. He stated Zenteno is a female. ██████████ stated he was waiting in the car under LVMPD event 160605-0520 after committing the robbery at the Speedee Mart under LVMPD event 160605-0430. See ██████████ *transcribed interview for more details.*

On June 12th, 2016, Detective Cardenas interviewed ██████████ at the Clark County Juvenile Detention Center. ██████████ stated that Perez and ██████████ came up with the idea of the robberies. ██████████ was shown a picture of the heavy set female in NVLPD event 160602-9496. The picture identified the heavy set female as Jaqueline Zambrano DOB ██████████. ██████████ stated that Zambrano was the driver in the robberies.

Perez: On June 12th, 2016, Detectives E. Cardenas and T. Weirauch conducted a recorded interview with Andrew Perez at the Las Vegas City Jail located at 3300 Stewart Ave, Las Vegas NV 89110. During the interview Perez stated the following: that he knows suspect #5 in LVMPD robbery events 160606-0201, 160606-0426, and 160606-0532 as ██████████. Perez stated he has known ██████████ since they were small children. Perez was shown photographs of LVMPD robbery events 160526-0182, 1604-0430, and NLVPD robbery event 160602-9496. Perez identified suspect #3 wearing the gray and black "zoo York" tank top in events 160602-9496 and 160604-0430 as himself. Perez stated that the female with a shaved head in LVMPD 160605-0520 during the shooting, has a music note tattoo on her right forearm. Perez stated the large build female seen in NVLPD event 160602-9496 during the robbery, owns the vehicle and was the driver on all the events. *See Perez's transcribed interview for more details.*

██████████ On June 13th, 2016, Detective T. Weirauch a recorded interview with ██████████ at 400 S. Martin Luther King Blvd, Metro HQ, with Gutierrez. Detective Weirauch read ██████████ his Miranda rights which he understood. ██████████ stated he committed 7 of the 8 robberies. ██████████ stated he shot at the

victim Gene McMillan under LVMPD event 160605-0520 two times. [REDACTED] stated he missed the first time and then aimed higher a McMillan and shot again. [REDACTED] stated he shot one time at the Rebel gas station under event 160606-0201 because he wanted the hostages to get down on the ground. See [REDACTED] *transcribed interview for more details.*

Zambrano: On June 13th, 2016, Detective Weirauch and I conducted a recorded interview with Jacqueline Zambrano at [REDACTED] inside my LVMPD vehicle. I read Zambrano her Miranda rights which she stated she understood. Zambrano stated she was the driver in all 8 robberies that occurred under events 16526-0182, 160604-0430, 160605-0430, 160605-0520, 160606-0201, 160606-0426, 160606-0532 and NLVPD event 160602-9496. Zambrano stated she used her mother's 2000, gold, 4 door, Dodge Stratus. Zambrano stated that she knew that [REDACTED] had shot the victim Gene McMillan after the media release of the event. Zambrano identified [REDACTED], Zenteno, and Perez being involved in the attempt murder event 160605-0520. Zambrano stated she parked behind the 7-11 and waited in the vehicle with Perez as Zenteno and [REDACTED] committed the robbery and shot McMillan in the head. Zambrano stated she continued to be the getaway driver for the robberies. Zambrano identified Perez and [REDACTED] as the ring leaders for all the robberies. Zambrano identified Zenteno being involved in 3 of the robberies. Zambrano stated she agreed to be the getaway driver because she did not have money. *See Zambrano's transcribed interview for more details.*

Zenteno: On June 15th, 2016, Detective Weirauch conducted a recorded interview with Zenteno at LVMPD HQ. Detective Weirauch read Zenteno her Miranda rights which she understood. Zenteno stated she was involved in robbery events NLVPD 160602-9496, LVMPD 160605-0430 and 160605-0520. Zenteno stated she was the lookout for robbery events NLVPD 160602-9496 and LVMPD 160605-0430. Zenteno stated Zambrano was the getaway driver in the robberies. Zenteno stated that she was involved in the attempt murder of Gene McMillan under LVMPD event 160605-0520 with [REDACTED]. She was shown a picture of Andrew Perez ID # 5169551 who she knows as "Moose". *See Zenteno's transcribed interview for more details.*

VICTIM STATEMENTS:

EVENT #160526-0182

Arthur Delatorre: On May 26, 2016, Mr. Delatorre completed a written statement at the Maverick convenience store located at 10490 Bermuda Rd, Las Vegas NV 89183. Delatorre stated he was cleaning inside the store. Three suspects entered with mask. He thought the suspects were kids playing around. He stalled for a while as one of the suspects repeatedly asked for the money from the register. He finally complied with the suspects demands and gave them the money. *See Delatorre's written statement for more details.*

NLVPD EVENT #160602-9496

Benita Reyes: On June 2nd, 2016, Ms. Reyes completed a written statement at the AM/PM located at 330 W. Centennial Pkwy, N. Las Vegas NV 89031. Reyes stated two men came into the store. One suspect man had a mask and the other man had a handkerchief/bandana covering his face. The suspect with the mask put money in a sack. The suspect with the handkerchief/bandana stole cigarettes. Rey's stated she was very nervous. *See Reyes's written statement for more details.*

Carrie Janell Hert: On June 4th, 2016, Ms. Hert completed a written statement at the Speedee Mart located at 2890 E. Tropicana Ave. Hert stated she was in the back of the office near the hot dog machine. She noticed the three suspects enter. Hert stated the suspects demanded money. She stated suspect #3 was holding a gun at her. Suspect #3 told her that "this is real, it's not a joke". Suspect #3 demanded her to open the safe. Hert stated she entered the code to the safe. Once the suspect got one tube of \$20 bills, they exited the store. Hert stated each tube equals \$100.00.

EVENT 160605-0520

Brooke Baumann: On June 5th, 2016, Ms. Baumann was interviewed by Detective J. Parra in his Metro vehicle at 4160 E. Sahara. During the interview, Baumann stated the following: She rode her bicycle from her home to the 7-11 located at 4160 E. Sahara. Baumann stated she entered the 7-11 and noticed the clerk was not at the front counter. She waited. Baumann stated approximately 30 seconds after she entered another female entered the 7-11 and walked around the store looking for the clerk. Baumann stated she waited at the counter and heard the female yell. Baumann stated she ran to the female and saw the victim lying on the ground with blood coming from his head. Baumann stated she ran to the front counter and tried to call 911 from the victim's cell phone. She stated she was unsuccessful and went back to assist the female. Baumann stated the female outside to get her own cell phone. Baumann stated the female called 911. *See transcribed interview for more details.*

Angela Quiroz: Mrs. Angela Quiroz was interviewed by Detective T. Weirauch at 4180 E. Sahara Ave, Las Vegas NV. During the interview Quiroz stated the following: she drove herself to the 7 11 in her cousin's vehicle. She parked the vehicle out front and walked in. Once she entered she saw another customer waiting at the register looking for the cashier. Angela started to call for the cashier and walked towards the North end of the store where she said she found the cashier on the ground. When she went to help him she could hear him breathing but he was unable to talk. She observed a wound to his head and told the other customer to call 9-1-1. She said the other customer tried to call 9-1-1 from the store phone, and the victim's phone but was unable to reach anyone. Quiroz said she went out to her vehicle and grabbed her own cellular phone and called 9-1-1. Angela tried to render aid while she waited for the police to arrive. Angela stated she did not see anyone exiting the area on her arrival. *See transcribe interview for more details.*

EVENT 160606-0201

Dustin Otis: Mr. Otis was interviewed by Detective J. Hanshew at the Rebel Gas Station. During the interview Otis stated the following: Otis stated that he was working as the lone cashier inside the Rebel when a Robbery occurred. Otis stated that three subjects entered the store. The suspects were described as Hispanic males in their mid-20's. Otis stated the first suspect entered and was wearing a white shirt and red hockey mask. Otis stated that the suspect was carrying a long barreled revolver and fired one shot into the ceiling as he entered. He stated that the second suspect was wearing a light colored shirt, had longer hair and was wearing a white hockey mask. The third suspect was described as wearing a black shirt, white hockey mask, and carrying a large machete. Otis described the third suspect as being taller and having a large build.

Once the suspects were inside the business, they demanded everyone to lie on the ground. The suspect with the red hockey mask along with the suspect with the large build demanded money from the cash register. During this time, the suspect with the long hair was taking Newport cigarettes, Swisher Sweets, Black and Mild cigars, and a large amount of Bic lighters. Otis stated that the money and merchandise was loaded into a blue backpack. Otis stated that one of the suspects took his knife and cell phone prior to leaving. Otis stated that suspects fled north out of the business. *See transcribed interview for more details.*

Vann Christian Murray: Mr. Murray was interviewed by Detective Parra in his Metro vehicle outside of the Rebel Gas Station. During the interview, Murray stated the following: He was shopping for items with his wife Diana at the Rebel Gas Station. As he and his wife were at the front counter to pay, he saw a suspect with a red mask enter the store and heard a gunshot. He saw the suspect with the red mask holding a long barrel revolver in his hand. They suspects shouted for everyone to lie down on the ground. Murray stated two more suspects entered behind with white mask. Murray stated he heard the suspects demand money from the victim. Murray stated that one of the suspects told him and his wife that they would not hurt them. Murray stated that once the suspects left the business, everyone laid on the ground for a while before calling 911. *See transcribed interview for more details.*

Diana Lopez: Ms. Lopez was interviewed by Detective Parra in his Metro vehicle outside of the Rebel Gas Station. During the interview, Lopez stated the following: She was shopping for items with her husband Vann inside the Rebel Gas Station. She heard a gunshot and was told to go to the ground by a suspect wearing a red mask. She stated she only remembered the suspects demanding money. She stated she did not get a good look at the suspects. *See transcribed interview for more details.*

Michael Darata: Mr. Darata was interviewed by Detective Parra in his Metro vehicle outside of the Rebel Gas Station. During the interview, Darata stated the following: He was playing video poker with his girlfriend Sara inside Rebel Gas Station. He saw the suspects with mask walk past the window. Darata stated the suspect with the red mask had a large barrel revolver. Two other suspects followed. All the suspects ordered everyone to the ground. The Suspects demanded money from the victim and fled out the front doors. *See transcribed interview for more details.*

Sara Hughes: Ms. Hughes was interviewed by Detective Parra in his Metro vehicle outside of the Rebel Gas Station. During the interview, Hughes stated the following: She was playing video poker with her boyfriend Michael inside Rebel Gas Station. She saw the suspects with mask walk past the window. Hughes stated the suspect with the red mask had a large barrel revolver. Two other suspects followed with white mask. All the suspects ordered everyone to the ground. The Suspects demanded money from the victim and fled out the front doors. *See transcribed interview for more details.*

EVENT 160606-0426

James Damm: On June 6th, 2016, Mr. Damm was interviewed by Detective Merrick at the Circle K convenience store, located at 2475 S. Nellis Blvd. During the interview Damm stated the following: Damm was working at the Circle K convenience store, located at 2475 S. Nellis Boulevard, when at approximately 0300 hours three masked men entered the store with a long barreled revolver and a machete. Damm complied with

the suspects and opened both registers. Damm said the suspect with the machete stood on the customer side of the counter and the other two suspects emptied out both register drawers, took money out of the "slot bucket", and took cigarettes. Damm said the suspects were in the store for approximately two minutes and before they left told him to get down behind the counter and wait five minutes to call police. The three suspects left in an unknown direction. Damm waited approximately five minutes then called 911.

Damm described the suspects as follows: #1- White or Hispanic male, 17 to 18 years old, 5'9"- 5'10" tall, wearing a red shirt, white mask, and holding a black long barreled revolver in his right hand. Damm said the suspect took money and Newport cigarettes. #2- White or Hispanic male, 20-21 years old, 5'9"- 5'10" tall, wearing a white mask, gloves and had a firearm. Damm said the suspect took Newport cigarettes and tobacco products. #3- Sounded like a BMA, 30-35 years old heavy set, 5'11" tall, with a large machete.

After the manager of the store conducted a countdown of the registers, it was determined the suspects took \$81.06 and unknown amount of tobacco product. *See transcribed interview for more details.*

EVENT 160606-0532

Christopher Jason Soult: Mr. Soult was interviewed by Detective Wildemann in his Metro vehicle outside of the 7-11. During the interview, Soult stated the following: He was working as a clerk inside the 7-11 when he saw a tan colored Dodge Neon back into a parking stall in front of the business. Soult could see one of the people in the back seat had a "Jason" mask on. Soult believed he was going to be robbed so he went to the register in an effort to drop money in the safe. Three men exited the Neon and entered the business. The first suspect was carrying a large frame revolver, black in color, 5'6" and weighing approximately 140 pounds. The second suspect was taller and heavy set and was carrying a large machete. He had no description for the third suspect as he was ordered to not look at their faces. The suspect with the machete told Soult to open the register, Soult obeyed. The suspects had Soult lay on the ground when they left. *See transcribed interview for more details.*

CONTACT STATEMENTS:

Daniel Velasquez-Wilson: On June 2nd, 2016, Mr. Velasquez-Wilson completed a written statement at the AM/PM located at 330 W. Centennial Pkwy, N. Las Vegas NV 89031. Velasquez-Wilson stated two men entered the store. One suspect had a white mask and the other suspect had a white bandana over his face. Velasquez-Wilson stated the suspect with the white bandana was carrying 2-3 boxes of cigars as the suspect exited. Velasquez-Wilson stated he saw a tan colored vehicle parked reverse in front of the store. He then saw the suspect vehicle speed off. *See Velasquez-Wilson's written statement for more details.*

██████████ On June 6th, 2016, Detective J. Hanshew conducted a recorded interview with ██████████ ██████████ stated the following: that she watched the news through Facebook and observed a video clip of a Robbery that occurred in a Las Vegas convenience store. ██████████ stated that she immediately recognized one of the suspects as her stepson, ██████████. She stated that ██████████ build and hair are the same as the suspect with a ponytail. ██████████ stated that ██████████ frequently wears the same pants and Vans style shoe. ██████████ recognized the way ██████████ walks and carries himself. ██████████ was very confident that ██████████ was the person in the Rebel Robbery video.

██████████ stated that ██████████ lives with his mother at ██████████ ██████████ stated that ██████████ visits her residence once a week. ██████████ stated that ██████████ arrived at her residence located at ██████████ ██████████ on June 6th. ██████████ had a green lunch bag in his possession. ██████████ stated she was being nosy, so she looked inside of the bag. ██████████ stated the bag contained a large amount of "Swisher Sweet" cigars (items taken in several robberies). ██████████ stated that she didn't want to confront him over the Robbery at that time. Later that day, ██████████ brother, ██████████, came over to ██████████ house to visit. ██████████ stated that she never spoke to ██████████ about the Robbery. ██████████ confronted ██████████ about the robberies. ██████████ stated that ██████████ yelled at ██████████ about seeing him on the news committing the Robbery. ██████████ stated that ██████████ became really nervous and ran from the house. She hasn't seen or heard from ██████████ since. See ██████████ *transcribed interview for details.*

██████████ On June 7th, 2016, a recorded interview was conducted with ██████████ DOB ██████████ (brother of ██████████). ██████████ stated that his brother was involved in recent robberies in the Las Vegas, North Las Vegas, and Clark County areas. ██████████ stated that ██████████ has a friend name ██████████ ██████████ stated that ██████████ is 4'5" or 5'5" in height, 140 lbs, has large poofy hair and a tattoo on left side of his neck. ██████████ stated that ██████████ has been seen in possession carrying a large frame revolver. ██████████ stated ██████████ recently gave him a hunting style knife and a white HTC cell phone (which was taken from the victim under LVMPD #160606-0201). ██████████ was shown a media release from event #160606-0201 and identified ██████████ as the suspect with the red mask and large framed revolver. ██████████ was also shown a media release of video surveillance under event 160605-0520 and identified ██████████ as the suspect wearing a black bandana, red shirt, and carrying the large framed revolver. ██████████ also identified ██████████ under event 160604-0430 and 160605-0430. During the interview, ██████████ was shown a Facebook picture of ██████████ ██████████ identified the picture as ██████████ friend ██████████ See ██████████ *transcribed interview for more details.*

CONCLUSION

Based on the aforementioned facts, Kimberly Zenteno was booked into the Clark County Detention Center for Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, Attempt Murder with a Deadly Weapon, Burglary with a Deadly Weapon, and Conspiracy to commit Attempt Murder..
