Overall Inspection Comments

ALLEGED COMPLAINT: I use to work in the same building as them so i would see everything. The place is dirty and has live/dead cockroaches everywhere. Most of the food looked and smelled spoiled just with new date tags on the containers. One of the owners that comes in at night smokes right around the server/cook areas. And not to long ago their drain system (separate from ours) that is linked to their sink over flowed so bad that the floor drain in the front by their server station over flowed with rottened food chunks coming up and out of it. And also their sanitation sink is hooked up to empty bottles of bleach. Also a few months back their pizza oven exploded and they were suppose to get it fixed by the manufacturer but I don't believe they did and you can still smell gas leaking from somewhere around it.--INSPECTOR COMMENTS:

Complaint investigated as part of a routine inspection. At time of inspection no person in charge was available. Manager arrived approximately 40 minutes after inspection started. Manager indicated complaint was filed by disgruntled employee who was recently terminated. At time of inspection no effective means of ware washing due to both dish machine and three compartment sink being in disrepair. No sanitizer available to either dish machine or three compartment sink and manager unable to demonstrate knowledge of proper ware washing. Dish ware in clean storage was found to be soiled and ware washing rack in use at dish machine contained an accumulation of microbial growth and soil. Manager indicates that no fire had occurred in establishment. However, Clark County Department of Building and Fire Prevention had issued a cease and desist for all cooking in establishment until repairs have been verified by the department. Manager indicates repairs (fire suppression system re-charged) have been completed but no written record of approval to resume operations was available. Establishment was actively cooking and frying under the hood ventilation system at time of inspection. Establishment is required to comply with all regulatory requirements outlined by Clark County Department of Building and Fire Prevention. No evidence of pest activity, sewage backups, or smoking were observed at time of inspection.

Verified Complaint for lack of sanitizer in operation. Fee is assessed. The complaint filed with the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) noted on this report has been found to be valid.
